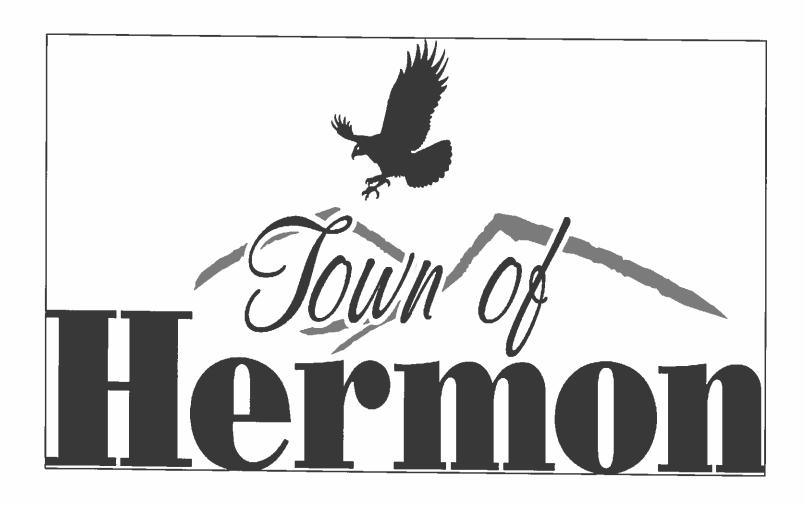

Annual Town Meeting Budget Approval Thursday, June 15, 2017

MINUTES

To: David Quinn a Constable for, the Town of Hermon, in the County of Penobscot, State of Maine,

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Hermon in Penobscot County, Maine, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the High School Auditorium in Hermon on Thursday the 15th day of June, 2017, at 6:30 p.m., then and there to act upon Articles 4 through 23 as set out below.

22 persons were in attendance. 17 were registered voters.

The Town Clerk opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. She then introduced, Moderator Jeremiah Rancourt and turned the meeting over to them.

Moderator Rancourt announced the results of the Election on Tuesday, June 13, 2017. He then reviewed the rules of procedure and voter rights regarding participation in the Annual Town Meeting.

Article 4: Shall the Town vote to appropriate the revenues received for the following accounts to offset the associated expense accounts, for fiscal year 2017-2018 with approval of the Town Council?

Moderator Rancourt read Article 4 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 4 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Moderator Rancourt read Article 4 a second time. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion. *The motion carries*.

Article 4 passes as presented.

Moderator Rancourt read Article 5 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 5 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. Moderator Rancourt read Article 5 a second time. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 5 passes as presented.

Article 6: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of up to \$36,000 from the Police Equipment Reserve (HERM01) to pay for a new police cruiser? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 6 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 6 as written. Jeanne Jacques seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Moderator Rancourt read Article 6 a second time. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion. *The motion carries.*

Article 6 passes as presented.

Article 7: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of up to \$66,000 from the Fire Equipment Reserve (HERM05) to purchase a new fire vehicle (\$36,000) and a new jaws of life (\$30,000)?

Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 7 aloud. Jeanne Jacques moved to approve Article 7 as written. Donna Pulver seconded the motion.

Doug Sinclair asked to address the Moderator. The Moderator complied. Mr. Sinclair stated that he understood the Council approved and recommended \$30,000 for the purchase of a new fire vehicle. He told how he met with the Fire Chief when the approved purchase price was \$25,000. After discussion \$30,000 was agreed upon. Mr. Sinclair stated that he did not know where the \$36,000 came from.

Doug Sinclair asked the Moderator to call for a motion to allow the Town Manager, who is not a registered voter in Hermon, to address this question. The Moderator called for a motion.

Tony Reynolds moved to allow the Town Manger to speak. John Snyer seconded the motion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Manager Kroll told how the Council reviewed, debated and approved the Budget as it is presented tonight. \$36,000 was the original amount requested in the budget.

Doug Sinclair moved to amend Article 7 to \$30,000 and lower the overall expenditure in the Article to \$60,000. John Snyer seconded the motion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 7 passes as amended.

Article 8: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of up to \$100,000 from the Highway Improvement Reserve (HERM06) in addition to the amount raised in the annual operating budget for drainage improvements, culvert replacements and surface repair for several Hermon Roads including Klatt Road, Crogan Road, Stoneybrook Drive, McDougal Drive and Westwood Drive?

Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 8 aloud. Anthony Reynolds moved to approve Article 8 as written. Donna Pulver seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Moderator Rancourt read Article 8 a second time. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion. *The motion carries*.

Article 9: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of up to \$75,000 from the Highway Improvement Reserve (HERM06) for clearing trees and brush from the right of way at Clark Road, Lewis Road, Newburgh (local portion), Bond Road, Blackstream Road, McDougal Drive and for curing other necessary sight distance issues? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 9 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 9 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Moderator Rancourt read Article 9 a second time. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion. *The motion carries*.

Article 9 passes as presented.

Article 10: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of up to \$60,000 from the Highway Improvement Reserve (HERM06) for engineering and drainage improvements on Odlin Road and New Boston Road intersection near Route 2 terminus? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 10 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 10 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Moderator Rancourt read Article 10 a second time. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion. *The motion carries*.

Article 10 passes as presented.

John Snyer, acknowledged by the Moderator, moved to eliminate the second reading of the Warrant Articles. Steve Watson seconded the motion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Second reading eliminated.

Article 11: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of up to \$100,000 from the Public Works Equipment Reserve Account (HERM08) to purchase a truck for year round work including winter road maintenance for use by the Public Works Department? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 11 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 11 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 11 passes as presented.

Article 12: Shall the Town vote to authorize an expenditure of up to \$15,000 from the Highway Improvement Reserve (HERM06) to pave a portion of Route 2 from Danforth's Plaza to Central Maine Harley Davidson? Recommended by Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 12 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 12 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 12 passes as presented.

Article 13: Shall the Town vote to authorize an expenditure of up to \$50,000 from Public Safety Building Reserve (HERM17) to install necessary catch basins and do vehicle access repair including pavement reclamation and replacement of surface at Fire Station parking lot? Recommended by Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 13 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 13 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 13 passes as presented.

Article 14: Shall the Town vote to authorize the transfer of funds from Tax Incremental Financing (TIF) Revenue in the amount of \$451,542, to off-set authorized expenditures for Economic Development general accounts #11-01-01-01 to 11-01-20-06 in the amount of (\$156,542); for account #30-16-57-16 Economic Development Reserve HERM16 (\$100,000); and account #19-02-25-03 TIF Credit Enhancement Agreements(\$195,000)? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 14 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 14 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 14 passes as presented.

Article 15: Shall the Town vote to authorize expenditures of up to \$100,000 from the Economic Development Reserve (HERM16) for improvements to Propane Lane (\$45,000), Autocar Lane (\$7,000), Mack Lane (\$8,000), Freedom Industrial Park Entrance(\$25,000), Gateway Sign (\$8,000) for Village District and surveillance cameras for the business parks (\$7,000)?

Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 15 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 15 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 15 passes as presented.

Article 16: Shall the Town vote to authorize an expenditure of up to \$33,000 from Sewer Reserve (HERM12) to install a SCADA System at Autocar Lane Pump Station, complete manhole riser repairs, clean and televise lines near Propane Lane and repair main line connections per Sewer Maintenance Plan?

Recommended by Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 16 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 16 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 16 passes as presented.

Article 17: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of \$200,000 from the School Tax Stabilization Reserve (HERM24) to offset a portion of the cost for the Hermon Middle School debt service in addition to the local appropriation for education? Recommended by Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 17 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 17 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 17 passes as presented.

Article 18: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of \$80,000 from the School Repair (HERM07) Reserve for repair of the roof at the Elementary School? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 18 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 18 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 18 passes as presented.

Article 19: Shall the Town vote to authorize the expenditure of \$70,000 from the School Repair (HERM07) Reserve to upgrade the heating system controls at Hermon High School? Recommended by the Town Council

Moderator Rancourt read Article 19 aloud. Doug Sinclair moved to approve Article 19 as written. John Snyer seconded the motion. There was no discussion. A show of hands was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The motion carries.

Article 19 passes as presented.

Article 20: Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate for municipal purposes for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 for the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018 the following sums of money?

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the Town of Hermon, Maine, as of and for the year ended June 30, 2017, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the Town of Hermon, Maine's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express opinions on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the respective financial position of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the Town of Hermon, Maine, as of June 30, 2017, and the respective changes in financial position, and, where applicable, cash flows thereof and the budgetary comparison for the General Fund for the year then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Other Matters

Required Supplementary Information

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that the management's discussion and analysis, schedule of Town's proportionate share of the net pension liability, and schedule of Town contributions, as listed in the table of contents, be presented to supplement the basic financial statements. Such information, although not a part of the basic financial statements, is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context. We have applied certain limited procedures to the required supplementary information in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, which consisted of inquiries of management about the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquiries, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge we obtained during our audit of the basic financial statements. We do not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the information because the limited procedures do not provide us with sufficient evidence to express an opinion or provide any assurance.

Other Information

Our audit was conducted for the purpose of forming opinions on the financial statements that collectively comprise the Town of Hermon, Maine's basic financial statements. The combining and individual fund financial statements and schedule are presented for purposes of additional analysis and are not a required part of the basic financial statements.

The combining and individual fund financial statements and schedule are the responsibility of management and were derived from and relate directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the basic financial statements. Such information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the basic financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the basic financial statements or to the basic financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. In our opinion, the combining and individual fund financial statements and schedule are fairly stated, in all material respects, in relation to the basic financial statements as a whole.

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Other Reporting Required by Government Auditing Standards

MANAGEMENT'S DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS (MD&A)

The Management Discussion and Analysis ("MD&A") is a report of the Town of Hermon's fiscal activity for the year ending June 30, 2017. The report is presented in a manner that fairly represents the town's present financial position in respect to all funds and accounts. Included is all the information to accurately understand the Town's financial position, and the data is correct to the best of our knowledge and belief.

The report includes funds and accounts that the Town of Hermon is required, either by legal or fiduciary duty, to maintain in the operation of all services. The use of the additional financial statements is encouraged to more fully understand the report.

The financial information of the Town includes all municipal departments (Public Works, Public Safety, Solid Waste, Recreation and Social Services, and General Administration) and the Hermon School Department.

BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

The Town of Hermon is primarily a residential community, however, a portion of the Town along the Bangor border on Route 2 and Coldbrook Road has multiple business parks. The growth of Hermon's business district has led to the utilization of resources available from the City of Bangor. Specifically, Hermon's water and sewer service is Town owned and maintained, but the service for these utilities is provided through the City of Bangor.

The residential portions of Hermon are a suburb to the Bangor Region and strive to maintain a rural character. Hermon is one of the more quickly growing communities in the State, and this growth created a population increase of approximately 25% from 1990 to 2000, and this trend has not changed since 2000. The growth, both commercial and residential, in Hermon, has created a continual increase to the Town's value and allowed the Town to maintain a mil rate below surrounding communities. Hermon is also one of the largest truck towns in the State of Maine. The Town relies heavily on excise tax from commercial vehicles to also keep the mil rate lower than other neighboring communities. However, the Town Council and administration are well aware that the continued growth puts larger demands on services, and efforts from the Town are to make sure the community is prepared for long-term success.

The goal of the community is to continue the success and growth of our business parks while maintaining separation for our residential community. Hermon's residential area continues its dedication to serve Bangor as a bedroom community that allows for country, family living. However, some business is encouraged in the village area to serve the residents. We have seen growth over the last 8 years of the shopping plaza, which compliments the community very well. The plaza includes a hometown grocery store, pharmacy, salon, dentist, insurance agents, chiropractor and acupuncturist, hardware store, Family Dollar, and Subway. These businesses are very important to the community, but the bulk of services continue to be available by traveling to Bangor.
