Be it resolved by the Hermon Town Council in Town Council assembled to approve ballot questions for the proposed track and football field renovation for consideration at the November 8, 2022, Town Election.

Question(s) as follows:

Shall the Town of Hermon authorize the Town Council to appropriate \$400,000 of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds, \$295,000 from the Hermon Elementary School Rec. Reserve Account, and \$300,000 from the School Repair and Maintenance Reserve Account, and borrow for a term not to exceed eleven (11) years up to a principal amount of \$2,700,000, at an estimated interest rate of 3.9%, for the purpose of all necessary construction and engineering costs for an improvement of Pottle Field, including the repair and installation of drainage, installation and purchase of bleachers, construction of storage facility, installation of well and pump house, and the installation of an eight lane track to the west of the tennis courts, and also authorize the Council to take all necessary steps and expend any necessary funds to execute the loan documents and issue general obligation bond(s) or note(s), including securing interim financing, with said funds to be from the amount appropriated or borrowed pursuant to this Question's passage?

2022 WARRANT SECRET BALLOT ELECTION TOWN OF HERMON November 8, 2022

To: Courtney Brown, a Resident of the Town of Hermon, Penobscot County and State of Maine,

Greeting: In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby requested to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Hermon, in said County of Penobscot, qualified by law to vote in said Town affairs, to meet at the Patricia A Duran School (Hermon Elementary School) on November 8th, 2022 at 6:45 AM then and there to act upon Article 1 and by secret ballot on Articles 2 through 3 as set out below, the polling hours therefor to be from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM, said articles being the following:

Note: The Election of Moderator by written ballot will be at 6:45 AM and voting will be from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM on November 8th, 2022.

ARTICLE 1. To elect a moderator by written ballot to preside at said meeting.
