Randy Bragg, Project Engineer of Carpenter Associates: Randy Bragg of Carpenter Associates, representing the project this evening. As you

indicated earlier this is our third attempt to come back with final approval we hope. We did work with DOT for about, it seems like a year now, to get that plan approved from them. The whole focus there was to make the intersection a lot safer. Everybody's been there and it's really tough to get in and out. I think we've made a lot of good improvement. The store is already down and I think everybody will agree that it looks a lot safer there already. You can see the whole intersection, people coming from all directions. So the primary, not really a lot of changes, just some details for signage, sidewalk markings, and defining these existing lanes currently. We were asked to take the road and move it further away from the intersection as far as we could so it would allow us to be able to come out and turn into the left lane to be able to turn left towards Bangor. They did ask us also to improve the right hand out lane to make sure nobody was sneaking in the back door. People will still do that but it's more of a deterrent in this position. And the other big thing that they asked was the town to leave enough space for a sidewalk to basically come from this street all the way to the front of the intersection and up into the store so we've added that as well. That's pretty much the improvements from the DOT. If you have any specific questions, I'd be happy to answer any of those regarding that or anything else. Thank you.

Nancy Delong at 21 Stage Rd: I just have a question. The sidewalk, are you going to be taking any of the First Choice Realty property? Like five feet? If I come down Stage Road and I want to hang a left is that five feet of sidewalk going to start there? And they will lose probably five feet of their lawn? I just had that question and how that was going to happen.
